

(d) Sewers in the regularised colony of Multani Mohalla, Rani Bagh were laid in the year 1975-76.

(e) It is proposed to provide kacha storm water drains where even open storm water drains do not exist so that the sewerage could be pumped into such drains till outfall sewers are completed.

Target of I.R.D.P. and SFDA in Madhya Pradesh

2747. DR. VASANT KUMAR PANDIT: Will the Minister of RURAL RECONSTRUCTION be pleased to lay a statement showing:

(a) whether the Integrated Rural Development Programme and Small Farmers Development Agency Programmes have not achieved target in Madhya Pradesh during 1979-80 and 1980-81;

(b) if so, the figures of Central allocation, amount released, M.P. State's share, Institutional finance and total utilisation in all the blocks of Madhya Pradesh for 1979-80 and 1980-81 (upto February, 1981);

(c) the figures of indentified beneficiaries and the actual beneficiaries under these programmes in Blocks covered by Districts of Rajgarh, Vidisha, Guna and Dhajapur during 1979-80 and the amount of utilisation as compared to the amount allotted; and

(d) what steps are being taken to intensify the fulfilment of these programmes in Madhya Pradesh?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE AND RURAL RECONSTRUCTION (SHRI BALESHWAR RAM): (a) to (d). Information is awaited from the Government of Madhya Pradesh and will be placed on the Table of the House as soon as it is received.

Rice Crop

2748. DR. VASANT KUMAR PANDIT: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) the total quantity of rice crop harvested during 1980; and

(b) the targets set for rice crop season for 1981?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE AND RURAL RECONSTRUCTION (SHRI R. V. SWAMINATHAN): (a) Final estimate of rice production for the crop year 1980-81 (July, 1980 to June, 1981) would be available after a few months. On the basis of preliminary assessment it is estimated that the kharif rice production would be about 52 million tonnes while summer rice crop, which has yet to mature, might yield another 4 million tonnes.

(b) For the crop year 1981-82 the target of rice production is still to be finalised by the Planning Commission.

Buyers for newly constructed DDA Flats at Trilokpuri and Dilshad Bagh

(a) whether it is a fact that newly constructed flats under LIG. MIG scheme at Trilokpuri and Dilshad Bagh in trans-yamuna area have remained vacant due to lack of buyers;

(b) if so, how many flats were built and for how many months they are lying vacant and the consequential loss to the DDA; and

(c) what was the response to these flats from public after the second advertisement?
