

मंत्री श्री प्रणव मुखर्जी ने फ्रांस की यात्रा की और वहाँ उन्होंने फ्रांस के विदेश व्यापार मंत्री से बातचीत की। मई, 1980 में पैरिस में दोनों पक्षों की मानिटैरिंग समिति की बैठक आर्थिक और तकनीकी क्षेत्रों में भारत-फ्रांसीसी सहयोग पर और फ्रांस के राष्ट्रपति की यात्रा के दौरान हस्ताक्षरित प्रोतीकोलों पर विचार करने के लिए हुई।

यूगोस्लाविया: महामान्य श्री वलैलिन जुरानोविक की यात्रा के दौरान 26 सितम्बर, 1980 को भारत और यूगोस्लाविया के बीच एक दीर्घकालिक करार पर हस्ताक्षर हुए। इस करार का मुख्य उद्देश्य उत्पादन-सहयोग करारों जैसे अपेक्षाकृत अधिक उन्नत रूपों में दीर्घकालिक औद्योगिक एवं तकनीकी सहयोग के माध्यम से भारत और यूगोस्लाविया के बीच आर्थिक संबंधों की और सुदृढ़ करना है।

आर्थिक क्षेत्रों में द्विपक्षीय सहयोग पर विचार करने के लिए भारत-यूगोस्लाविया आर्थिक सहयोग संयुक्त समिति का नेहरूवां अधिवेशन नई दिल्ली में 16 से 19 फरवरी 1981 के बीच हुआ।

दोनों देशों के बीच का मौजूदा सांस्कृतिक आदान-प्रदान करार 1980 और 1981 के दो वर्षों के लिए है।

पोलैंड: दोनों देशों के प्रतिनिधिमंडलों के बीच अधिकारी स्तर की बातचीत मार्च, 1981 में वारसा में हुई। इस बातचीत के परिणामस्वरूप, वर्ष 1981 और 1982 के लिए एक नये सांस्कृतिक आदान-प्रदान कार्यक्रम को अंतिम रूप दिया गया।

आर्थिक, व्यापारिक एवं तकनीकी सहयोग से सम्बद्ध भारत-पोलिश संयुक्त आयोग का छठा अधिवेशन मार्च, 1979 में नई दिल्ली में आर्थिक एवं तकनीकी क्षेत्रों में पारस्परिक सहयोग की समीक्षा करने के लिए हुआ।

(ग) भारत की सरकार उन सभी मित्र देशों के साथ पारस्परिकता के आधार पर सहयोग और संपर्कों को बनाए रखने की कोशिश में रहती है जिनके साथ भारत के राजनयिक संबंध हैं।

Measures to encourage Family Planning in M.R.T.P.

7005. SHRI BALASHEB VIKHE PATIL: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have taken or propose to take measures to encourage family planning both with the workers and employers in the establishments attracting MRTP;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI NIHAR RANJAN LASKAR): (a) Government have taken measures for providing population education and family planning motivation to workers and employers in the Industrial Sector by starting Organised Sector projects for involving Trade Union Organisations, and Employers Organisations which may include members of establishments attracting MRTP Act.

(b) Employers' Organisation.

(i) All India Organisation of Employers (AIOE)

This was started on 1-2-1980 for a period of three years with the commitment of United Nations Fund for Population Activities for assistance to the extent of \$61,370. The objective is to evolve a strategy for greater collaboration between employers and workers organisations in developing viable models of suitable population education programme for promotion of Family Welfare and Health, through orientation and motivation of executives, supervisors and the workers at

the plant level. The project is being implemented in Kanpur, Patna and Ludhiana.

(ii) *Employers Federation of India (EFI)*:

This project was started on 1-11-1979 for a period of three years with the commitment of financial assistance from UNFPA to the tune of \$86,210. The objectives are the same as those of the AIOE Project. It is being implemented at Pune and Madras.

Trade Union Organisations

(i) *Indian National Trade Union Congress (INTUC)*

This project was started from 1-9-1976 for a period of two years but was extended till 31-3-1980 with financial commitment of UNFPA to the tune of \$91,570. The aim was to provide an institutional set up to guarantee some degree of continuity in population education undertaken by INTUC. The acceptance of small family norm among the industrial workers affiliated to this body was to be achieved through educational and motivational means.

(ii) *Hind Mazdoor Sabha (HMS)*:

This project was cleared on an *ad hoc* basis and was started in 1977. It was thereafter approved by UNFPA with financial commitment to the tune of \$1,21,040 and re-scheduled from 1-7-1979 to 31-12-1981.

(c) Does not arise.

Bad Quality tea and milk at Railway Stations

7006. SHRI K. PRADHANI: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are aware that adulterated and bad quality of tea and milk are being sold at small and big stations

(b) if so, whether there is any check by the Railway authorities at the stations in this regard;

(c) whether Government are aware that particularly in the night time, adulterated bad quality of tea and milk and even poor quality of food is being served to the passengers; and

(d) if so, the measures Government have taken in this regard?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS AND IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI MALLIKARJUN): (a) to (d) Some complaints about unsatisfactory quality of tea and milk have been received.

To ensure that good quality of milk is used and tea served is of good quality, periodical inspections, surprise check and special drives are conducted by the inspectors and officers of the Commercial and Medical Departments. Samples of tea leaves and milk are frequently taken from departmental as well as contractors-run catering units and sent for analysis.

Mobile clinics provided to Bihar

(a) how many mobile clinics have been provided to Bihar under the Reorientation of Medical Education Scheme; and

(b) how many villages of Bihar have been benefited by this scheme?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI NIHAR RANJAN LASKAR): (a) and (b) Twenty-seven Mobile Clinics have been provided to Bihar under the Reorientation of Medical Education Scheme for the nine medical colleges
