7009. SHRI BHEEKHABHAI: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to refer to the reply given to Unstarred Question No. 2397 on the 5th March, 1981 regarding Railway bookstalls and states:

- (c) whether it is a fact that the monopoly groups still enjoy the benefits of holding bookstalls in Railways; and

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS AND IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PARLIA-MENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI MALLIKARJUN): (a) All future allotments of bookstalls at stations and on trains are now exclusively reserved for Cooperative Societies of Actual Workers/Vendors of the existing Contractors, Cooperative Societies of unemployed graduates, partnerships/Associations of unemployed graduates and individual unemployed graduates.

Unemployed Graduates belonging to Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and their Cooperative Societies etc. are also eligible for these contracts.

- (b) Only a few partnerships and Associations of unemployed graduates are operating bookstall contracts. No Cooperative Society has yet come forward for allotment of a book-stall contract. There is, therefore, no case of ignoring the interests of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.
 - (c) and (d) No monopoly rights exist on the Railway's for any book stall contractor.
