## Creation of Posts of All India Services

3022. SHRI NARAYAN SAHU. Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) the number of IAS and IPS officers and other categories of officers of All India Service posted in each State and Union territory of India: and

(b) what are theguidelines under which the posts of All India Serivces are created?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS AND DEPARTMENT OF PARLIA-MENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI P. VEN-KATASUBBAIAH) (a): Information in regard to the number of Officers of the Indian Administrative Service, Indian Police Service and Indian Forest Service, which are the three All India Services, borne on each State/ Joint Cadre (including the Union Territories Cadre) of these Services as on the 1st January, 1980 is given in the attached statements I, II and III.

(b) Posts are encadred in the various State/Joint Cadres of the India Services generally be taking into account the following considerations:—

(i) anticipated additional manpower requirements on account of the increased tempo of social and economic development under the Ftve Year Plans:

(ii) encadrement of such of the posts temporarily added to the cadre by the cadre authority as are required on a long term basis;

(iii) encadrement of non-cadre posts under the State Governments declared equivalent to cadre posts, wherever necessary, with special attention to those posts which have continued for over three years;

(iv) exclusion, where considered

necessary, of cadre posts kept in abeyance for period exceeding six months;

(v) exclusion, where considered necessary, of specialised posts which should ordinarily be manned by technical officers.
