Treatment of leprosy patients in government hospitals

3345. SHRI HARINATH MI-SRA: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) wether it is a fact that leprosy cases are not being treated in Government Hospitals cither by the Centre or State Governments;
- (d) if so, the reasons and justifications for the same; and
- (c) if not, what is the actual position and the number of cases being treated in Government hospitals at present, State-wise?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI NIHAR RANJAN LASKAR):

- (a) No. However, some general Hospitals are not treating leprosy cases.
- (b) Reasosn for certain general Hospitals not treating leprosy cases are partly due to fear of public objection and partly to leprosy patients being reluctent to come to such places for fear of ostracisation by patients.
- (c) The exact number of patients treated in such hospitals is not readily available but about 2.69 million cases are taking treatment at different general and special leprosy centres, both Government and Voluntary, in the country and 32655 indoor beds are available for leprosy patients.
