Cochin Unregistered Dock Workers (Regulation of Employment) Scheme, 1980

4309. SHRI M. M. LAWRANCE: Will the Minister of SHIPPING AND TRANSPORT be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have approved a scheme namely Cochin Unregistered Dock Workers (Regulation of Employment) Scheme, 1980; and

(b) if so, when this will be implemented?

THE MINISTER OF SHIPPING AND TRANSPORT (SHRI VEERENDRA PATIL): (a) and (b) A scheme called Cochin Unregistered Dock Workers (Regulation of Employment) Scheme, 1980 was notified in the Gazette of India on 27-9-1980 inviting objections/suggestions to the proposed scheme from concerned interests. Some objections have been received. A final view with regard to implementation of the proposed scheme shall be taken after considering the objections/suggestions.

Setting of a Cancer Research and Treatment Centre in campus of S.C.B Medical College, Cuttack

4310. SHRI RAMA CHANDRA RATH: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government propose to establish a Cancer Research and Treatment Centre in the campus of S. C. B. Medical College, Cuttack during the current financial year;

(b) if so, the total amount so far provided to this Cancer Research Centre for buying equipment, etc;

(c) whether Government have also the proposal to provide financial assistance to open two similar Cancer Research Centres in Orissa, one each at Berhampur and Sambalpur; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI NIHAR RANJAN LASKAR): (a) The Government has already selected the Cancer Department of the S. C. B. Medical College, Cuttack for its development as a Regional Cancer Research and Treatment Centre.

(b) Rs. 6.50 lakhs

(c) and (d) No such proposal is under consideration of the Government. However, it is proposed to give Central assistance to the Government of Orissa for installation of a Cobalt Therapy Unit with rotating head and collimation facilities at the V. S. S. Medical College, Burla, (Sambalpur).

Modern Cargo container-cum training ship

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS AND IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI MALLIKARJUN): (a) to (d) A proposal for construction of road over-bridges in replacement of existing level crossings at Chhapra Junction has been under the consideration of the Railway and the State Government. A foot over-bridge to enable the public to cross the railway tracks is also under construction on west end of Chhapra Junction Station and is expected to be completed by June, 1981.
