#### Allotment of Wagons

8475. SHRI JYOTIRMOY BOSU: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the owners of M/s. Ramani Mohan Industries (P) Ltd., 20, Abdul Hamid Street, Calcutta-700069, a small manufacturer of minerals and chemicals products, have been repeatedly urging the Railway Board to allot wagons for loading Dolomite and limestone lumps (essential raw materials) at their Scdepur factory;

(b) whether Government are aware that due to non-allotment of wagons production at the factory has almost come to a standstill; and

(c) if so, what action, if any, has been or is being taken by the Railway Board on the said representations?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS AND IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI MALLIKARJUN): (a) Yes.

(b) and (c) The supply of wagons is made in accordance with seniority and priority of indents. Lime stone and dolomite when sponsored by State Governments and consignee being a Government official in his official capacity is entitled to priority 'C'. Lime stone, when consigned to sugar factories is cleared under priority 'D'. The movement of lime stone and dolomite on account of private parties is arranged under priority 'E', which is the lowest priority. During the period October, 1980 to March, 1981, 14 wagons were loaded with dolomite for M/s. Ramani Mohan Industries (P) Ltd., from Dausa to Sodpur. As on 31-3-81, only 10 demands for dolomite and 27 demands for lime stone were pending on account of this party. These demands will be cleared in turn soon.
