The Andamans Special Allowance without any restrictions has been allowed to the employees of the Forest and Plantation Corporation with effect from 1-4-1980 on the basis of the Personnel Manual approved by the Board of Directors under the powers delegated to them with the approval of the Bureau of Public Enterprises. Similar concession is not enjoyed by the locally recruited employees of other Public Sector Undertakings such as the Shipping Corporation of India, State Bank of India and the life Insurance Corporation in the territory.

It has been decided to study the feasibility of replacing the existing Andamans Special Allowance and Compensatory Allowance by a suitable Compensatory Allowance, taking into consideration the cost of living and also various other facilities, at present enjoyed by the employees of that Andaman and Nicobar Administration.
