munity facilities. In case, it becomes necessary to demolish any unauthorised construction which cannot be adjusted in the regularisation plan, alternate land/ffat/accommodation is required to be given to the families displaced in this process.
(d) The Delhi Administration has reported that a decision in this regard will be taken at appropriate time in consultation with the concerned authorities with minimum possible dislocation.
(e) The rate of compensation vari$e_{s}$ from land to land and from village to village.
