VIth Five Year Plan at a total cost of Rs. 38.82 lakhs (the ICAR cost being Rs. 30.55 lakhs on 75:25 basis). The Bidhan Chandra Krishi Vishwa Vidyalaya in West Bengal is proposed as one of the seven centres under this Project. The project is awaiting consideration and clearance of the Planning Commission and Ministry of Finance.
