(b) The meeting reviewed :

- (i) The financial resources for the Plan both of the Centre and the States for the year 1981-82;
- (ii) The implications of the preliminary results of the 1980-81 population census;
- (iii) I he problems in the implementation of the programme of rural development, in particular the integrated rural development programme and the national rural employment programme; and
- (iv) Lessons to be drawn for Plan implementation from the experience derived from implementation of Plan schemes during 1980-81.

The review indicated the need for renewed emphasis on family planning programme, speedy execution of projects, greater financial discipline and strengthening of the planning and monitoring machinery at all levels.
