THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENERGY (SHRI VIKRAM MAHAJAN): The State

Electricity Boards of Andhra Pradesh Bihar, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Rajasthan and Tamil Nadu have not incurred losses totality for the 5 years ended on 31st March, 1979 (for which information is available), after taking credit for rural electrification subsidies. The following State Electricity Boards have suffered losses for the 5 years ended on 31st March, 1979 in totality after making provisions for (i) Interest on Government loans; (ii) Depreciation; and (iii) Other revenue deficits, if any:
