जिस गाडी का जिक्र किया गया है वह १६ ४५ पर बहराइच पहुंचती है श्रीर नानपारा हो कर मिहिनपुरवा नहीं, सीधी नैपाल गंज जाती है। इसलिये इस भझाव का मतलब यह होगा कि इस गाड़ी को नानपारा ग्रीर मिहिनपुरवा हो कर कत्रिनयांघाट तक चलाया जाय। फिर भी, इस गाडी को मिहिनपुरवा से आगे चलाना ममिकन न होगा क्योंकि निशानगढा-कतरनियांघाट मेक्शन: रात में गाड़ी चलाने की इजाजत नहीं है।

Rail-Sea Co-ordination Committee

369 { Shri Raghunath Singh: Shri Tantia:

Will the Minister of Transport and Communications be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the report of the Rail-Sea Co-ordination Committee has been submitted; and
- (b) if so, whether it is a fact that the Committee has recommended general 15 per cent. enhancement in coastal freight rates for two years ending with March, 31, 1959?

The Minister of State in the Ministry of Transport and Communications (Shri Raj Bahadur): (a) Yes, Sir, The report was submitted on 17-4-1957.

(b) The recommendations of the Committee are still under the consideration of Government.

Over-bridge at Shalimar

370. Shri Muhammed Elias: Will the Minister of Railways be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government propose to construct an over-bridge at Shalimar No. 3 gate, South-Eastern Railway; and
- (b) if so, when the same will be undertaken?

The Deputy Minister of Railways (Shri Shahnawaz Khan): (a) This level crossing has been recommended by the State Government to be placed by an over/under Bridge. The proposal involves acquisition of valuable property for the approaches, the feasibility of which is to be decided in consultation with the State Government. Unless this examination completed, it is not possible even to formulate a definite proposal for the constructions of an over or underbridge.

(b) Does not arise.

Shencottah Trivandrum Railway Line

371. Shri Kumaran: Will the Minister of Railways be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government have investigated the possibility of opening a railway line from Shencottah to Trivandrum via Kulathoopuzha Nedumangadu; and
- (b) if so, the results of the investigation?

The Deputy Minister of Railways (Shri Shahnawaz Khan): (a) No.

(b) Does not arise.

Railway Line in Rajasthan

372. Shri Shobha Ram: Will the Minister of Railways be pleased to state:

- (a) the total mileage of Railway lines to be opened in Rajasthan during the Second Five Year Plan; and
- (b) how does this figure comparewith those of other States?

The Deputy Minister of Railways (Shri Shahnawaz Khan): (a) No new lines have been included in Rajasthan in the Second Five Year Plan. However 26 26 miles of Fatehpur Churu line, started in the First Five Year Plan, has been opened in the Second Five Year Plan.

The Raniwara- Bhiladi line, started in the First Five Year Plan. also establish a link with Rajasthan.
