The under-developed countries have, however laid greater emphasis on Community Development work of the type undertaken in India subject to adjustment according to local conditions. Work on this line is in progress in the following countries:

- (4) Iran.
- (5) Iraq.
- (6) Nepal.
- (7) Pakistan.
- (8) Phillipines.

## Universities and Community Development Work.

(a) whether it is a fact that Universities and other educational institutions have been requested to include a subject on Community Development in their syllabi;
