## Scheme of National Associationship for Scholars

1947. SHRI KAMALNATH: Will the Minister of EDUCATION AND SOGIAL WELFARE be pleased to state:
(a) whether University Grants Commission has decided to introduce a new scheme of three year Nationa ${ }^{1}$ Associationship fcr scholars; and
(b) if so, the salient features the reof and the number of scholars to be covered with duration thereof?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRIES OF AILWAYS and EdUCATION AND SOGIAL WELFARE AND DEPARTMENT OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI MALLIKARJUN): (a) and (b). The scheme of Naticnal Associationships of the Univerity of Grants Comm ssion has been in opera tion since 1971-72. So far, two categories of awards were made under the scheme, one vaild for cne year, and the other for five years. The scheme enables serving teachers or scientists to visit, and participate in the programmes of, instituticns of their choice, for periods upto tbree months in an year. If the place of such vi isit is cutside their headquarters, they are paic an allowance of Rs. 5000/- a month, besides the cost of travel. The five-year awards permitted three such visits during the award.

In October, 1981, the Commission made a modification in the scheme according to which one-half of the existing five-year Associateships has been converted into thrée-year
