refusal to follow rules such as entry by rear-gate etc. The clashes and hold-upsof )TC busesbythe students have been for various reaso including those which have no connection, even remotely, to DTC operations. There wese 51 hold-ups by the students in 1979, 68 in 1980 and 15 during January-October, 1981. The cost of damage to the buses has been Rs. 17,319, Rs. 63101 and Rs. 37.393 respectively. The excludes loss of revenue as a result of missing of trips due to hold-ups.

(c) Besides the normal city services available to the students, the number of special trips for the convenience of students is increased on the recommendations of the Appex Committee consisting of the representatives of Delhi University, Delhi University Students Union, Delhi Police and the DTC. The number of such special trips has increased from 742 in 1979, to 779 in 1980 and 940 in 1931.

Thenumber of buses in DTC'sown fleet wis increased from 2283 cn 31st March, 1979 to 2754 on 31st March, 1931. During the current year, DTG have further addead42 buses to its fleet by 30th November. 1981.

## Institution of Advanced Studies Simla

1946. DR. KARAN SINGH : Will the Minister of EDUCATION AND SOCIAL WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether a final decision has been taken regarding converting the Institute of Advanced Studies Simla, into a majorCentre for Philoshical Studies; and

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THEMINISTRIESOFRAIL WAYS EDUCATION AND SOCIAL WEL-FARE, AND DEPARTMENT OF PARLIAMENTARYAFFAIRS (SHRI MALLIKARJUN): (a) and (b). An expert Committee was appointed to recommend the reorganisation and restructuring of the Indian Institute of Advanced Study, Simla. The Committee has submitted its report. However, no final decision has so far been taken on the recommendations made by the Committee.

## Scheme of National Associationship for Scholars

1947. SHRI KAMALNATH: Will the Minister of EDUCATION AND SOCIAL WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether University Grants Commission has decided to introduce a new scheme of three year National fcr scholars; and Associationship

(b) if so, the salient features the reof and the number of scholars to be covered with duration thereof?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRIES OF AILWAYS AND EDUCATION AND SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEPARTMENT OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI MALLIKARJUN): (a) and (b). The scheme of National Associationships of the Univerity of Grants Commission has been in opera tion since 1971-72. So far, two categories of awards were made under the scheme, one vaild for one year, and the other for five years. The scheme enables serving teachers or scientists to visit, and participate in the programmes of, institutions of their choice, for periods upto three months in an year. If the place of such visit is cutside their headquarters, they are paid an allowance of Rs. 5000/- a month, besides the cost The five-year awards perof travel. mitted three such visits during the award.

In October, 1981, the Commission made a modification in the scheme according to which one-half of the existing five-year Associateships has been converted into three-year
