- (c) The outlay proposed for Orissa under the Inter-State Tasar Project is Rs. 1.60 erores during the project period. Under this programme 1000 hectares will be brought under Arjun Tasar Plantation, covering districts of Mayur Bhanj, Keonjhar, Sundargarh, Denkanal and Cuttack Districts of the State and will provide direct employment to 1000 tasar tribal rearing families in these areas.
- (d) The Project will be implemented in two phases, 1981-82—1983-84 being the first phase. Based on its review the second phase will be taken up during 1984-85—1985-86.
