Will the Minister of ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that some major coal mine projects are running far behind schedule;
 - (b) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether his Ministry has initiated talks with other coordinating Ministries for the early completion of those major coal mine projects; and
- (d) the expected time of the completion of those coal mine projects?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENERGY (SHRI VIKRAM MAHAJAN): (a) Of the seventy nine major coal mine projects

being implemented by different subsidiaries of Coal India Limited, eleven projects are more than three years behind schedule.

- (b) Reasons for delay in implementation of these projects are broadly as follows:—
 - (i) Delay due to land not being available in time and/or law and order problems.
 - (ii) Difficult geomining conditions met during development of mines and/or technology not available for working these deposits,
 - (iii) Non-availbaility of plant and machinery.
 - (c) Yes, Sir.

This is being done wherever necessary.
