- (b) the number of passenger and goods trains so far brought under diesel traction; and
- (c) what are the details regarding the targets for the year 1981-82?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE RAILWAYS MINISTRIES OF EDUCATION AND SOCIAL WELFARE THE DEPARTMENT OF AND IN AFFAIRS (SHRI PARLIMENTARY MALLIKARJUN): (a) Diesel locomotives are more efficient than steem locomotives as their hauling capacity is greater, they are capable of achieving and acceleration is higher speeds better. The servicing requirement for diesel locomotive is very much less than that for steam which require frequent halts for watering and coaling. The range of operation of much giving very diesels is also fiexibility permitgreater operating ting through running of goods trains. Thus dieselisation contributes to considerable saving in line capacity, coal consumption and improved operation. Moreover, steam traction becomes progressively uneconomical in areas with higher traffic densities.

- (b) As on 1-11-8I, 280 BG diesel locomotives and 102 diesel MG for use on allotted locomotives are Passenger services. Freight traffic is catered for by 1172 BG diesel and 350 MG diesel locomotives. The actual worked with number of goods trains these locomotives would depend on trailing load, etc. pattern of traffic, However, 64 per cent on BG and 66 per cent on MG of freight train Km in 1980-81 were hauled by diesel traction.
- VERSON A V (c) The additional diesel main line locomotives which become available during 1981-82 would be deployed for passenger and goods trains depending on operating need, urgency, etc. In this regard, 87 BG diesels. 15 MG diesels and 7 NG diesels are scheduled for manufacture in 1981-82.
