Indians in Ceylon

390. Shri Shivananjappa: Will the Prime Minister be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Labour Minister of Ceylon recently announced a new scheme to implement Government's Ceylonisation Policy on Estates; and
- (b) if so, whether this new policy affects the surplus Indian immigrant labour?

The Prime Minister and Minister of External Affairs (Shri Jawaharlai Nehru): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The Government of Ceylon have assured the Indian High Commissioner in Ceylon that their intention is not to disturb anyone already employed, but only to ensure that new vacancies or new jobs are shared, particularly, those in entirely new areas that are to be opened up and put under tea, under expansion schemes already contemplated.

Allocation to Himachal Pradesh tor the Second Five Year Plan

391. Dr. Y. S. Parmar: Will Minister of Planning be pleased state:

- (a) the toal amount sanctioned for Himachal Pradesh towards expenditure under the Second Five Year Plan for 1956-57 and 1957-58 and the amount spent towards the plan ir 1956-57 and in 1957 upto 31st August
- (b) whether it is a fact that progress of the Plan in Himacha Pradesh is according to schedule; and

(c) if not, what steps Government propose to take to accelerate it?

The Deputy Minister of Planning (Shri S. N. Mishra): (a) to (c). Against the Five year outlay of Rs. 1472-53 lakhs, and amount of Rs. 288'90 lakhs was budgetted for 1956-57 and a provision of Rs. 321'30 lakhs made for 1957-58. Details of expenditure incurred are not yet available. A statement showing the progress of expenditure is laid on the Table of the Lok Sabha. [See Appendix II, annexure No. 6]. Further information is awaited from the Himachal Pradesh Administration.

Handloom Industry in Mysore
