

Auction of Garment Units in Loni

466. SHRI GEORGE FERNANDES: Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are aware that all the units of Garment Complex, Loni in Ghaziabad have been auctioned;

(b) whether this is due to non-fulfilment of the commitments made by the State Bank of India, the U.P. Financial Corporation and the U.P. Export Corporation;

(c) whether the concerned units have approached the Small Industries Service Institute, Kanpur and the Development Commissioner Small Scale Industries for assistance;

(d) whether the State Bank of India are taking any steps to get these units revived; and

(e) if so, the details thereof?
