(b) During this period 45,392 persons were enrolled in Lok Schayak Sena camps in Uttar Pradesh. Of these 4,004 joined the camps in the districts of Azamgarh, Varanasi, Ballia, and Jaunpur.

(c) The scheme of Lok Sahayak Sena was initiated on the 1st May 1955 and aimed at training 5,00,000 persons by the end of March 1960. Upto 20th February 1958, 528 camps have been held at selected places in the country and about 2,65,000 persons trained.

Processing of raw hides in Harness and Saddlery Factory

During the year 1957-58, the intake of raw hides for processing was somewhat lower as compared to the corresponding figure for 1955-56 and 1956-57 for the reason that some quantity of hides in semi-processed state was available in the factory's stock. There was, however, no fall in overall production during the year 1957-58 as compared to the two previous financial years.
