

Pradesh) have recently raised the question of further Central assistance for removing the disparities between the emoluments of their employees and those of the Central Government.

A decision has been taken for the present to liberalise the scale of Central assistance so as to provide for Central assistance at uniform rate of two-thirds of the expenditure entailed on the States in giving relief to their low-paid employees, provided that the increase does not exceed Rs. 12/- p.m. in any individual case and the total emoluments after the increase do not exceed Rs 100/- p.m.

The amounts that would be payable to the various State Governments under this modified scheme have not yet been worked out.

हिन्दी परीक्षाएँ

१८१ श्री अनिरुद्ध सिंह : क्या शिक्षा और वैज्ञानिक गवेषणा मंत्री यह बताने की कृपा करेंगे कि :

(क) क्या यह सच है कि केन्द्रीय सरकार ने सरकारी नौकरियों में नियुक्ति के लिये विभिन्न संस्थाओं द्वारा ली जाने वाली हिन्दी परीक्षाओं को मान्यता दी है ; और

(ख) यदि हा, तो उन हिन्दी संस्थाओं के नाम क्या हैं जिनके प्रमाण-पत्रों को मान्यता दी गयी है ?

शिक्षा और वैज्ञानिक गवेषणा मंत्रालय में राज्य-मंत्री (डा० का० ला० श्रीवाली) : (क) तथा (ख). भारत सरकार ने विभिन्न संस्थाओं द्वारा संचालित किसी भी हिन्दी परीक्षा को अब तक मान्यता प्रदान नहीं की है। परन्तु, जहाँ पर केन्द्रीय सरकार के प्राधीन किसी पद या सेवा में नियुक्ति या स्थायीकरण के लिये हिन्दी की योग्यता आवश्यक ठहरायी गई है, वहाँ पर जो व्यक्ति राष्ट्र भाषा प्रचार समिति वर्षा का कोविद प्रमाण पत्र पा चुके हैं उन्हें कोई और पात्रता-

परीक्षा पास करने की आवश्यकता नहीं है। यह तब तक है जब तक कोई और भाषा नहीं दिया जाता। इस प्रश्न पर विचार करने के लिये जिस मान्यता समिति को नियुक्त किया गया है उसकी रिपोर्ट देखने के बाद इस प्रमाण पत्र को और दूसरी संस्थाओं की हिन्दी परीक्षाओं को मान्यता देने के सम्बन्ध में अंतिम निर्णय किया जायगा।

Copper Mines

The Minister of Mines and Oil (Shri K. D. Malaviya): There are three copper mines working in India viz., at

(i) Mosaboni-Badia;

(ii) Surda; and

(iii) Pathargora.

All these are located in Singbhum District of Bihar State.

Minerals Wealth of Andhra Pradesh

(a) whether Government have perused the Andhra Pradesh Government bulletin released on the 8th January, 1958 regarding the mineral wealth in Andhra Pradesh; and
