National Construction Corporation

2335. Shri Ram Krishan: Will the Minister of Irrigation and Power be pleased to refer to the reply given to Starred Question No. 292 on the 20th November, 1957 and state the main terms and details of the agreement under which the Punjab Government have agreed to join the National Construction Corporation?

The Deputy Minister of Irrigation and Power (Shri Hathi): No special terms have been negotiated.

Payment to Staff on South-Eastern Railway

2336. Shri Kumbhar: Will the Minister of Railways be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the permanent and temporary staff on the South Eastern Railway are not being paid regularly;

(b) if so, the number of such cases pending on the 1st March, 1958; and

(c) the steps which are being taken in the matter?

The Deputy Minister of Railways (Shri Shah Nawaz Khan): (a) to (c). No. But in 199 cases as on 1-3-58 there was delay for technical reasons such as competent sanction not being given. Steps have been taken to ensure that such delay does not recur.

Indian Agriculture Research Institute

2337. Shri M. V. Krishna Rao: Will the Minister of Food and Agriculture be pleased to state:

(a) how many quarters are there in Indian Agricultural Research Institute (I.A.R.I.) estate;

(b) which Department is in charge of the quarters;

(c) whether there are any framed rules for allotting the quarters; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

The Minister of Food and Agriculture (Shri A. P. Jain): (a) There are 361 quarters as detailed below:—

(b) The C.P.W.D. is in charge of the maintenance and allotment is being made by the Director, Indian Agricultural Research Institute, New Delhi.

(d) A copy of the rules is laid on the Table of the Lok Sabha. These rules are under revision and are expected to be finalised as soon as the C.P.W.D. have worked out the revised rents for the quarters at the I.A.R.I. under the rationalisation system. [See Appendix VII, annexure No. 61.]

Dairy Development Scheme

2338. Shri Bhagavati: Will the Minister of Food and Agriculture be pleased to state:

(a) what programmes have been taken up and executed in Assam upto 1956-57 under the Dairy Development Scheme; and

(b) the actual expenditure on the Dairy Development Schemes during the first two years of the Second Plan in the State of Assam and the amount allotted for this purpose for the same period?

The Minister of Food and Agriculture (Shri A. P. Jain): (a) The following Dairy Development Schemes costing about Rs. 18.63 lakhs are included in the Second Five Year Plan of Assam:

(i) 1 Co-operative Milk Union of 150 maunds capacity,

(ii) 1 Rural Creamery.
