1-10-81 Prosecution filed has been stayed by the High court of Delhi on 19-11-81, on a writ petition filed by the company.

Failure to register 4-7-78 undertaking the Section 26.

Proceedings before the Metropolitan Magistrate, New Delhi, have been Adjourned 27-3-1982

Expansion of Streptomycin Plant

2716. SHRI RAMAKRISHNA MORE: Will the Minister of PETRO. LEUM, CHEMICALS AND FERTI-LIZERS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government spent about Rs. 7 crores on the expansion of streptomycin plant to get 180 to 200 tonnes p.a.; and
- (b) if so, the reasons why the actual production during the last two years is much less after expansion, when 100 tonnes were achieved prior to expansion ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM, CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS DALBIR SINGH): (a) Government have approved the expansion of Streptomycin capacity of Hindustan Antibiotics Limited from 85 tonnes per annum to 170 tonnes per annum at an estimated cost of Rs. 608.15 lakhs.

(b) The expansion scheme has been completed and trial runs are now under way. The production during the last three years is as follows:

> 1978-79 100.27 tonnes 1979-80 91.03 tonnes 1980-81 91.01 tonnes

Implementation of National Grid

2717. SHRI ARVIND NETAM: Will the Minister of ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) what are the reasons for the delay in the implementation of national grio; how many kilometres were supposed to have been laid to complete the national grid and how many kilometres have actually been laid;
- (b) what is the requirement of large size ACSR conductors for the next five years for this purpose and how it will be finanaced; and
 - (c) the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENERGY (SHRI VIKRAM MAHAJAN). (a) While he Government have accepted in principle, the need for an integrated national electricity system, the mechinics of creating a National Power Grid have to be worked out in consultation with the different State Governments/State Electricity Boards, etc. In this connection, the State Governments/State Electricity Boards have already been requested to furnish their considered views in the matter.

(b) and (c). Do not arise.

Setting up TV Station at Bhubaneswar

2718. SHRIMATI JAYANTI PATNAIK: Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROAD-CASTING be pleased to state:

(a) when is the new T.V. Station at Bhubaneswar going to be set up I and

(b) what is its cost and what facilities would be available in this complex?

THE MINISTER OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI VASANT SATHE): (a) and (b). There is a proposal to locate a T.V. Centre at Bhubaneswar. The expenditure estimated at present will be Rs. 191 lakhs.

Power Generation Target and Achievement

2719. SHRIMATI JAYANTI PATNAIK: Will the Minister of ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) the power generation target of the country for 1981-82 and 1982-83;
- (b) whether the target for 1981-82 has been achieved; and
 - (c) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENERGY (SHRI VIKRAM MAHAJAN): (a) to (c). The energy generation target for the year 1981-82 is 122000 MU. It is expected that the target fixed for 1981-82 will be achieved and is likely to be exceeded. The targetted generation for 1982-83 is 132000 MU.

- (a) the total number of new connections of LPG given in Bombay from January 1980 till January 1982 of (1) Bharat Petro leum and (2) Hindustan Petroleum respectively; and
- (b) the details of the new connections that will be given in future?
