

Assam and the Union Territories of Manipur and Tripura

(b) and (c). The State Bank's pilot scheme for advancing loans to small scale industries will shortly be extended to Dibrugarh in Assam State. The scheme is not being extended to the Union Territories of Tripura and Manipur as the State Bank has no branch in these areas. The assistance which the small scale industries in these Territories obtains is under the State Aid to Industries Act.

Supplies Dropped in NEFA

699. Shri L. Achaw Singh. Will the Prime Minister be pleased to state

(a) the total quantity of supplies dropped in NEFA during 1957, and

(b) the total amount of freight paid to the private companies for such supplies during that year?

The Prime Minister and Minister of External Affairs and Finance (Shri Jawaharlal Nehru): (a) 8,869.5 Tons Gross

(b) An amount of Rs 23,33,917 has been paid in 1957 to private companies in part payment of their bill for the supplies dropped by them in 1957

Meeting of Partition Body

700. Shri Hem Raj: Will the Prime Minister be pleased to state

(a) whether the Partition Body of the two Punjabs met recently to settle the outstanding matters between India and Pakistan,

(b) if so, the matters discussed and the decisions taken thereon, and

(c) how far they have been implemented?

The Prime Minister and Minister of External Affairs and Finance (Shri Jawaharlal Nehru): (a) Yes Sir. A meeting of the Punjab Implementation Committee was held in Chandigarh on the 17th and 18th October, 1957

Uranium Ore

701. Shri Shobha Ram: Will the Prime Minister be pleased to state:

(a) the names of the areas in Rajasthan where uranium ores have been discovered,

(b) the nature and potentiality of each area with their analysis results, and

(c) whether the Department of Atomic Energy is going to instal an upgrading plant for treatment of low grade uranium ores of Rajasthan?

The Prime Minister and Minister of External Affairs and Finance (Shri Jawaharlal Nehru): (a) and (b) A number of Uranium ore deposits of various types have been discovered in Udaipur and Jaipur Divisions and Ajmer and Alwar Districts in Rajasthan. Detailed investigations are still in progress for ascertaining the assay value of the ore bodies in bulk and the nature and extent thereof on the basis of which their potentiality for commercial exploitation may be judged

(c) An experimental ore-dressing plant is already in operation at one of the prospects and others are intended to be put up where necessary for preliminary investigations. The question of setting up a full-scale ore-dressing plant will be taken up when the existence of large commercial sources of ore has been established

Madurai Ramnad Chamber of Commerce

702. Shri Tangamani: Will the Minister of Commerce and Industry be pleased to state

(a) whether the Madurai Ramnad Chamber of Commerce gave a Memorandum to him regarding oil and oil

seeds during his visit to Madurai on the 24th December, 1957; and

(b) if so, what steps have been taken to meet their demands?

The Minister of Commerce and Industry (Shri Morarji Desai): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The suggestions made regarding oils and oilseeds were—

- (i) groundnut oil might be allowed export and coconut oil imported to replace groundnut oil; and
- (ii) exports of groundnut oilcake should be limited to 100 tons at a time per shipper.

The first suggestion was not found acceptable because coconut oil is not a suitable substitute for groundnut oil in the Vanaspathi industry where it is mostly required. As regards the second suggestion, export of groundnut oilcake is now regulated through established shippers on the basis of past exports.

पासपोर्ट

७०३. श्री क० भे० मालवीय : क्या प्रधानमंत्री यह बताने की कृपा करेंगे कि :

(क) क्या गत एक वर्ष में जाली पासपोर्टों के कुछ मामले सरकार के ध्यान में आये हैं;

(ख) यदि हाँ, तो उनकी संख्या कितनी है; और

(ग) सरकार अपराधियों के विरुद्ध क्या कार्यवाही कर रही है ?

प्रधानमंत्री तथा वैदेशिक कार्य और वित्त मंत्री (श्री जवाहरलाल नेहरू) :

(क) जी हाँ।

(ख) दिल्ली, लखनऊ और मद्रास के रीजनल पासपोर्ट अफसरों ने जाली पासपोर्टों के १८० मामलों की रिपोर्ट भेजी। बंबई और कलकत्ता के रीजनल पासपोर्ट अफसरों से सूचना इकट्ठी की जा रही है।

(ग) ऐसे मामलों से जिन लोगों का संबंध है उनके नाम ब्लैक-लिस्ट में रख दिए गए हैं और उनके पासपोर्ट रद्द कर दिए गए हैं। जहाँ कहीं संभव है, पुलिस कानून तोड़ने वालों के खिलाफ उचित कार्यवाही कर रही है।

Cottage Industries

704. Shri Daljit Singh: Will the Minister of Commerce and Industry be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is a proposal to develop some more cottage industries in Kangra district of the Punjab State; and

(b) if so, the kind of cottage industries proposed to be developed?

The Minister of Commerce and Industry (Shri Morarji Desai): (a) and (b). In addition to providing training in the weaving of *pashmina* carpets, hooked rugs, *namdas* and chain-stitch embroidery on *namdas* and hessian cloth and the establishment of a plantation-cum-demonstration centre for rearing silk worms in Kangra District which would be continued during 1958-59, it is proposed to develop in that year training in manufacture of wooden toys, bamboo articles and *niwar* and tapes.

(a) the names of textile mills which remained closed upto the end of January, 1958;

(b) the reasons therefor;

(c) whether any steps have been taken to start these factories or mills;
