Facilities are provided through the Extension Service Centres for manufacture of jigs, tools and fixtures, wherever such Extension Centres have started functioning.
- (ii) All necessary help, by way of allowing import of raw materials which are not available indigenously, is being given to the firms, subject to the availability of foreign exchange.
- (iii) Indigenous allocation of raw materials like steel and pig iron is made to the firms to enable them to carry on the production. Also each
