#### **Flow of sullage and sewage in storm water drain in Moti Bagh, New Delhi**

(a) whether he is aware that for the last so many months sullage and sewage has been flowing in the storm water drain along D-II Type Flats on Ring Road in Moti Bagh-I posing a grave danger to the health of the residents;

(b) whether none of the concerned bodies, namely NDMC, Delhi Municipal Corporation and DDA is prepared to take any action or own responsibility in the above matter, ignoring all complaints made by the affected people; and

(c) whether Government would issue immediate instructions to the concerned authority to attend to the complaint of the residents by taking immediate remedial steps?

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to lay a statement showing:

(a) State-wise number of unemployed persons in rural areas when the "National Rural Employment Programme" was started;

(b) State-wise number of persons given (i) permanent or/and (ii) temporary employment since then under this programme; and

(c) the nature and categories of the employment provided?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRIES OF AGRICULTURE AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI BALESHWAR RAM): (a) National Rural Employment Programme, formerly known as Food for Work Programme, was started in April, 1977. No survey was conducted regarding unemployment situation in April, 1977. However, an employment/unemployment survey was conducted by NSSO during July, 1977 to June, 1978. A statement (I) showing State Level unemployment rate (in per cent) estimated on the basis of this survey is enclosed.

(b) Under Food for Work/National Rural Employment Programme employment is provided on daily basis. Information in regard to employment generated is collected in terms of mandays only and not in terms of number of persons given employment. A statement (II) containing the information in this regard from the year 1977-78 to 1981-82 is enclosed.

(c) The employment provided under the programme is mostly of the unskilled type which involves physical work like earth work etc. Some employment for the skilled workers like masons, carpenters, blacksmiths etc., is also provided.
