 - (c) if so, reasons thereof?

THE MINISTER OF PARLIAMEN-TARY AFFAIRS AND WORKS AND HOUSING (SHRI BHISHMA NARAIN SINGH): (a) Out of 20 towns cated to West Bingal for loan assistance under the scheme for Integrated Development of Small and Medium Towns, project reports for have been received. These towns are---

- (b) Yes, Sir.
- (c) According to the guidelines of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme for Integrated Development of Small and Medium Towns, though they are part of the integrated development project schemes for slum improvement State in the provided for plan and are not eligible for Central assistance under the Scheme. State Government have not indicated the reasons for not including improvement in the integrated gramme. However, they have requested to make adequate outlays in the State and Local Body Sector.

Condition in Delhi Zoological

8388. SHRI R. P. GAEKWAD: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state-

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Delhi Zoological Park is not being kept neat and clean and it odours foul smell due to stagnant water and stinking water-canals:
- (b) whe ther it is also a fact that too many birds are lodged in the same enclousre, the Hippopotamus, Chimpanzees, Peacocks, Jackals and Rabbits and most of the animals live in their own excreta and there is all round decay and sickness; and
- (c) how Government propose improve the upkeep of the Zoo?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRIES OF AGRICUL-TURE AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI R. V. SWAMINATHAN): (a) No. Sir. The Delhi Zoological Park is one of the better maintained zoological parks in the country.

- (b) No, Sir. The birds are kept in aviaries designed for this purpose. The hippopotamus, chimpanzees, peacocks, jackals and rabbits are kept in separate enclosures which are cleaned regularly
- (c) Government has appointed an Advisory Committee for advising on the proper management of the Delhi Zoological Park. In addition, there is a panel of honorary veterinarians, which advises and assists the zoo staff in the treatment of animals.
