increased from a level of 2.43 lakh tonnes in April-December'80 to 3.11 lakh tonnes in April-December '81, The coal companies have also been releasing coal freely by road against the shortfall in rail movement to all industrial consumers and can meet the demand in full.

## Indian Films Exhibited in Filmotsav'82 and Criteria for their Selection

405. SHRI MADHAVRAO SCINDIA: Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROAD-CASTING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a fortnight long Filmotsav 1982, was convened in Calcutta in January this year;
- (b) what were the Indian Films exhibited in the Filmotsav and what were the criteria for their selection; and
- (c) how far the Filmotsav was successful?

THE MINISTER OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI VASANT SATHE): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The selection of Indian films for the Filmotsav '82 was made on the recommendation of a Selection Panel comprising of eminent film personalities and the criteria for selection was primarily their artistic significance and aesthetic excellence. The following 20 films were screened in the Indian Panorama Section of the Filmotsav '82.

Apart from this, a retrospective to celebrate the Golden Jubilee of Indian Talkies was screened. 20 Indian films were selected in Hindi and other regional languages representing works from important film studios like New Theatres, AVM and Prabhat Talkies.

(c) The Filmotsav '82 at Calcutta was generally successfull. Apart from the films in the Indian Section about 100 foreign films including a retrospective of Godard, Guney and Janeso were screened. A package of 16 mm films showing the latest trend in the British cinema as well as important works from the 3rd world were also screened. The Festival was attended by about 80 important film personalities from abroad including Film-makers, Artists and Film Critics and over 900 Delegates representing the Indian Fim Industry.
