Implementation Silent Valley Hydro-electric Project has been held up on account of serious reservations expressed from environmental angle. The Report of the Joint Centre-State Committee on the Silent Valley Hydro-electric Project, set up for this purpose, is still awaited. The question of implementation of Silent Valley Project would be reviewed after the recommendations of this Committee are received.

THE MINISTER OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI VASANT SATHE): (a) to (c). During VIth Plan the following cities are to be connected by microwave link:—

- 1. Delhi-Jullundur-Srinagar
- 2. Jullundur-Amritsar
- 3. Delhi-Lucknow-Calcutta
- 4. Lucknow-Kanpur
- 5. Lucknow-Varanasi
- 6. Calcutta-Murshidabad
- 7. Calcutta-Asansol
- 8. Bombay Pune
- 9. Bombay-Panaji
- Madras-Madurai
- 11. Hyderabad-Vijayawada
- 12. Delhi-Jaipur

Under the INSAT Scheme, it is proposed to connect all the TV Centres in the country via INSAT by providing S-Band relay receivers at all the centres with uplink facilities for National linkage at Delhi. Firm demand has been placed on P&T for uplink at Delhi and a letter of intent for S-Band relay receivers is also placed on BEL. National linkage through INSAT will be progressively achieved during 1982 and 1983.

(d) The scheduled dates of completion of linkage through micro-wave links and the present position are given in the attached statement.
