from Kerala Govt., Kerala Dinesh Beedi supplied two consignments of beedis to Switzerland firm named "Magic Garden" during 1980. This firm has placed another order for 24,000 beedis recently on Kerala Dinesh Beedi.

Frauds/Thefts/Dacoities in Banks

10438. SHRI R. P. SARANGI: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state the total amount involved in (i) Frauds, (ii) Thelts, (iii) dacoities, and (iv) misappropriation covering the period from the year 1978 to 1982 concerning the branches of State Bank of India—Nagpur and Vidarbha Region?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI JANARDHANA POOJARY): According to the information furnished by the State Bank of India, there have been no thefts or dacoities in its branches at Nagpur and Vidarbha Region. However, disclosure of details of frauds, in respect of individual banks, is not in public interest. Information relating to frauds in the State Bank Group, in the last five years, is indicated below:
