thal stations on the Pathankot-Juliundur section of the Northern Railway on the 26th February, 1959; and

(b) if so, what efforts are being made to trace the culprits?

The Deputy Minister of Railways (Shri Shahnawax Khan): (a) Yes. A blank grenade was found near the railway track between Kandrori and Mirthal railway stations on 25-2-59 and not on 26,2 1959.

(b) According to the opinion of the Ammunition Expert of the Army it was a dummy 3" grenade and did not contain any explosive. It appears that this material was left by some army personnel during the course of their training and no foul play is suspected. No case, therefore, has been registered by the Government Railway Police.
