A road over-bridge in reglamment of the existing level crossing had been foreseen but in view of the anticipated diversion of most of the vehicular traffic along the realigned State highway, the question of providing a Toot-over-bridge instead of a mad-over-bridge is under consideration in consultation with the State Government.
