- (b) whether there is any yardstick for posting the different grade of staff in the Signal and Telecom Department; and

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS AND IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI MALLIKARJUN): (a) Duties of Inspectors and Maintainers are as shown in the Statement attached.

- (b) Yes.
- (c) Yardstick for supervisory Signal Inspectors exist which is applicable all over the Railways. As regards Junior Grade/ Sectional Signal Inspectors and Signal Maintainers (Mechanical or Electrical) each Railway evolves its own yardstick depending upon the local conditions traffic density and the type of equipment.

Yardstick for maintenance of Microwave equipment, as applicable all over the Railways exists for telecom, staff and inspectors. The issue of yardstick for the maintenance of telecommunication equipments in Railway Electrification area is under consideration.
