- (2) Six teams have been established in different regions to determine the P. falciparum sensitivity to Chloroquine.
- (3) Administration alternative of drug-combinations drugs and wherever lack of response to Chloroquine been has encountered.
- (4) A Central Reference Laboratory has been established to crosscheck the slides of P. falciparum monitoring teams.
 - (5) National training courses to train officers and technicians have been undertaken for in vitro testing techniques.
