Though it is situated on the coast, yet, strictly speaking, it cannot be described as a coastal steel plant. Nor is the construction of any other coastal steel plant contemplated.

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY AND STEEL AND MINES (SHRI NARAYAN DATT TIWARI): (a) Apart from periodical internal exercises, the Report on Industrial Dispersal submitted by the National Committee on the Development of Backward Areas contains an evaluation of the working of Central incentives and concessions for the setting up of industries in backward areas. Copies of the Report are available in the Parliament House Library. As part of its operational procedure, the National Committee got studies conducted by the Industrial Development Bank of India of the impact of Central concessions and in centives in the Districts of Khammam and Chittoor in Anddra Pradesh, Nasik and Chandrapur in Maharashtra, Moradabad
