**Shortage of Newsprint**

5218. SHRI BALASAHEB VIKHE PATIL : Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be pleased to state :

(a) whether Government have conducted any study of raw material sources for producing newsprint in the country or drawn up any project report for exploiting the raw material;

(b) if so, what are the details in this regard;

(c) whether it is a fact that the country is facing a great shortage of raw material for newsprint;

(d) if so, what steps Government have so far taken to meet the shortage of newsprint raw material; and

(e) what are the names of the countries which have assured or supplied raw mate-

rial for newsprint in 1980, 1981 and so far in 1982?

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY AND STEEL AND MINES (SHRI NARAYAN DATT TIWARI) : (a) and (b) Government are aware of the potential sources of raw material for the production of newsprint.

(c) and (d) As conventional sources of raw material for newsprint are not sufficient to meet the needs of the Industry, Government are encouraging the use of unconventional raw materials, and approvals have been granted for the manufacture of newsprint from bagasse and by recycling mixed waste paper and used newsprint.

(e) Wood pulp which is the main raw material for producing newsprint is being imported from New Zealand, Canada, North America & Sweden on competitive basis.
