

Civilian authorisation to civilian Officers (CGO's) cadre

5429. SHRI BABURAO PARANJPE: Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether 20 per cent civilian authorisation has been given to civilian officers (CGO's) cadre also;

(b) if not, the reasons therefor; and

(c) is it a fact that JCOs/NCO's having 10 years service are commissioned against the vacancies of officers from the 20 per cent authorisation of civilians ignoring service career of more experienced office superintendents having more than 30—35 years of service?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE (SHRI K. P. SINGH DEO): (a) No, Sir.

(b) The officers cadre is manned by Service/Civilian Officers as per job requirements.

(c) No, Sir. JCOs/NCOs are granted Commission against posts tenable by Service officers of the cadre concerned.

Collection of Transparencies in Photo Library of ITDC

5430. SHRI NGANGOM MOHENDRA: Will the Minister of TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that ITDC has a huge collection of transparencies in its Photo Library to be used for the production of literature on behalf of the Department of Tourism for the promotion of tourism in India; and

(b) if so, what is the procedure adopted for purchase of transparencies?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI KHUR-SHEED ALAM KHAN): (a) Yes, Sir. The India Tourism Development Corporation Ltd. has a collection of transparencies in its Photo Library for use in the production of tourist publicity

literature on behalf of Department of Tourism, Government of India.

(b) Depending upon the need, ITDC purchased transparencies from photographers who approach the Corporation on their own from time to time. Besides, transparencies are obtained from photographers who are assigned special coverage to meet specific requirements for the publicity literature being produced by the ITDC.

Automatic telephone device at Palam Airport

5431. SHRI P. RAJAGOPAL NAIDU: Will the Minister of TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether Indian Airlines has installed an automatic telephone device with memory relating to details of flight movement at Palam Airport; and

(b) if so, whether it is on permanent basis?

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI A. P. SHARMA): (a) and (b). Indian Airlines is planning to introduce Automatic Telephone Answering and Announcing machines for disseminating information of arrivals and departures of their flights at major airports namely, Delhi, Bombay, Calcutta, Madras, Bangalore and Hyderabad. The machine is under development by Indian Telephone Industries. Bangalore and one model is presently under test at Delhi Airport.
