- (iii) Insulated drop wires are being used for telephone lines.
 - (iv) Replacement of aluminium wires by copper wires in the subscribers premises.
 - (v) A new improved telephone instrument is being inducted in the telephone system.

Delivery of Letters in Andhra Pradesh

1872. SHRI K. A. SWAMI: Will the Minister of COMMUNI-CATIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government are aware of the general public feeling that letters are being destroyed and not delivered in substantial numbers in Andhra Pradesh;
- (b) the steps taken to institute vigilance to allay the fears of the public in Andhra Pradesh; and
- (c) the details of measures initiated in this matter?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMU-NICATIONS (SHRI YOGENDRA MAKWANA): (a) to (c). The Government are not aware of such a feeling in the General Public in Andhra Pradesh. When in rare and isolated cases, mischief on the part of some individual employee is detected, thorough investigation is made and departmental and legal action is taken, Existing departmental rules and instructions provide for regular check and supervision over the delivery staff.

Power charges for various categories of Consumers

1873. SHRIB. R. NAHATA: Will the Minister of ENERGY be pleased to lay a statement showing:

(a) the power charge on domestic, industrial and other categoeies of

consumers in each State during the last five years;

- (b) the total earning of each State as a consequence of sale of energy during the last five years;
- (c) number of units generated in each State and the number of units charged for from consumers during the last five years; and
- (d) the amount of (i) energy charges and (ii) taxes recovered in each State during the last five years per unit?

- (c) what recommendations have been rejected by Government and which are still under consideration; and
- (d) how much time Government will take in implementing these recommendations?
