(a) whether the conditions of houses where officers and men have to work in the Hilli check post are bad;

(b) whether it is a fact that though there is an adequate plot of land that belongs to Government no attempt has been made to build new constructions for officials and passengers;

(c) whether Government are aware that the incoming and outgoing passengers who cross border in the evening and have to stay at the check post, find great difficulty as there is no waiting hall or room or arrangement for toilet for men and women; and

(d) if so, the action Government propose to take to give relief to all concerned?

Attack on a family in JNU campus

2133. SHRI INDRAJIT GUPTA: SHRIMATI GEETA MUKHERJEE:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) the facts relating to the attack made on Dr. Harbans Mukhia and his wife on 21 June, 1982 at their residence in the JNU Campus;

(b) whether any of the assailants have been identified and apprehended;

(c) whether there are serious complaints about the inactivity of the local police and their possible collusion with the culprits, if so, the reaction of Government thereto;

(d) whether the JNU Teachers Association has demanded greater security measure in the area, if so, the action taken in the matter?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS AND DEPARTMENT OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI P. VENKATASUBBAIAH): (a) On 21.6.1982, at about 3.00 A.M., 3 unknown persons broke open a rear door of Prof. Harbans Mukhia's house in J.N.U. Campus and entered the house. The intruders gave blows with iron rods to Prof. Mukhia and his wife. They fired a shot in the air and made good their escape under cover of darkness.

(b) Not yet, Sir.

(c) It is not correct that there is any collusion of the local police with the criminals.

(d) In addition to the Security Guards of the JNU the police have deployed constables on the Campus near staff quarters, hostel and Professors' residences. A motor cycle fitted with a wireless set remains on patrol duty in the Campus.
