A communication dated 8-3-1982 was received from the Railway Licensed Catering Employees Union, Dindigul complaining against SShri G. Raju Naidu and G. K. Radhakrishnan, existing catering vending contractors at Dindigul, about non-supply of uniforms, Medical certificates, identify cards etc. to the workers and non-Implementation of the agreement reached between the Union and the contractor Shri G. K. Radhakrishnan. The complaints were investigated and it was found that the contractors are discharging their contractual obligations properly and the staff are in possession of police Medical certificates, uniforms; etc.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SHIPPING AND (SHRI TRANSPORT SITARAM KE-SARI): (a) and (b) Transport sector accounts for 45.6 per cent of the total for North-Eastern approved outlay Council's Sixth Five Year Plan. A provision of over Rs. 200 crores has also been made in the Sixth Plan in Central Sector for various schemes of maintence and improvement of Roads and Brides in the North-Eastern Region.
