#### Delivery of mini-car rake by Jessops and Company Limited

3260. SHRIMATI PRAMILA DAN-  
DAVATE: Will the Minister of RAIL-  
WAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that only  
one Mini-Car-Rake out of 18 booked in  
1978 for Central Railways was deli-  
vered by M/s. Jessops and Company,  
Limited, in May, 1982;

(b) if so, the reasons thereof;

(c) when the balance of rakes is  
expected to be delivered; and

(d) whether in view of the increas-  
ing pressure of traffic on the Bombay  
suburban Central Railways and can-  
cellation of number of trains Govern-  
ment propose to take steps to expedite  
the supply of required rakes to meet  
the commitment?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE  
MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS AND IN  
THE DEPARTMENT OF PARLIA-  
MENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI MALLI-  
KARJUN): (a) No. An order for 239  
EMUs comprising of 26 Nos. of 9 Car  
Rakes and some spare Motor Coaches  
and Trailer Coaches was placed in  
November, 1978 on M/s. Jessop & Co.

Ltd. Calcutta. Against this order they have supplied 1 number of 9 Car Rakes upto May, 1982 and 1 more 9 Car Rakes in June, 1982.

(b) Initially there was some delay in supply of inputs by the Railways and M/s. Jessops had also faced certain teething troubles, which have now been sorted out and the firm has commenced series production.

(c) Part of the order quantity is expected in 1982-83, the balance EMUs are expected to be delivered in 1983-84 and 1984-85, depending on funds availability.

(d) As about 11 Rakes are expected in 1982-83 and further substantial quantities in 1983-84, the shortage of Rakes is expected to be overcome.

#### **Employment of Medical Graduates**

3261. SHRI A. NEELALOHITHADASAN NADAR: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) the average number of Medical Graduates coming out every year; and

(b) whether the Government of India and State Governments are unable to provide employment to all those Medical Graduates?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE: (KUMARI KUMUD BEN M. JOSHI): (a) Approximately 13,000 medical graduates are passing out, every year.

(b) The Government is aware of unemployment among doctors. Pub-

lic Health is on the State List and it is, therefore, basically for the State Governments to evolve suitable employment schemes for utilising the services of the available stock of doctors.

A considerable step-up in the job opportunities for medical graduates is expected in the wake of the implementation of the various Plan Schemes in the Health and Family Welfare sector, during the Sixth Five Year Plan and beyond. The nationalised banks also offer loans for enabling doctors to establish clinics/nursing homes in the rural areas.

#### **Railway Coach Factories**

3262. SHRI A. NEELALOHITHADASAN NADAR: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) how many Railway Coach factories are there at present in India;

(b) their details Railway-wise;

(c) whether there is any proposal to start a Railway Coach Factory in Kerala within the limit of the Southern Railway; and

(d) if so, the details of the proposal and the action taken in that respect?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS AND IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI MALLIKARJUN): (a) There are 3 coach building workshops and 29 coach repair workshops at present in India.
