The Minister of Commerce (Shri Kanunge): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b During the current licensing period, the item Danmer Batu has been separately specified vide S. No. 49(a)(ii)IV of the Import Trade Control Schedule and the quota seduced to 30 per cent.

1276. Shri K. U. Parmar: Will the Prime Minister be pleased to state:

Indian Trainces in U.K. without Valid Passports

(a) whether it is a fact that a large number of Indian trainees are at present in the U.K. without valid passports, after having "jumped ship"; and

(b) whether any steps are being taken to enable them to return home?

The Prime Minister and Minister of External Affairs (Shri Jawaharlal Nehru): (a) The total number of Indian merchant seamen trainees, who are reported to intre "jumped ship" in the U.K. minos 1985, is 330.

(b) When any such trainee applies to the Indian High Commission in London for facilities for repairiation, either on a working passage or as a passenger, the High Commission issue him an Emergency Certificate walld for return to India and assist him to obtain a working passage. Six persons were so repatriated during 1958 and 1959.

Tibetan Refugees

1278. Shri Manaen: Will the Prime Minister be pleased to state the number of Tibetan refugees in Sikkim, Kalimpong and Darjeeling?

The Prime Minister and Minister of External Affairs (Shri Jawaharlal Nehru): 4,820 in Sikkim, 1,444 in Kalimpong, and 44 in Darjeeling, ss on 15th November, 1959.

Raw Material for Woollen Industry

(a) whether it is a fact that there is acute shortage of raw material for the woollen industry; and
