(b) Promotions to the grades of Section Officers/Stenographers Grade 'B' are made in equal proportion through the limited departmental competitive examination and on the basis of seniority. Since the condition of age limit was not there for promotion on the basis of seniority, it was considered appropriate to remove this condition in respect of examination category.

(c) Yes, Sir.

(d) For determining the merit of candidate for a senior Stenogrphic post, this performance in an examination, including his technical kill (i.e. stenography) has to be ested as a whole.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISYRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI NIHAR RAJAN) :

(a) Yes, Sir,

(b) The Society was set up as a we'fare measure with a view to providing consumer articles of daily to the 'arge body of Government servants 'iving in the various resiresidentia' co'onies in De'hi/New De'hi. The Government is, therefore, interested to see that Society fulfils the objectives for which it was set up. The purpose behind the order is not to hamper the day to day activities of the Society, but on'y to have n independent source of 'information about the proper functioning of the retai' stores. There is, therefore, no question of withdrawing the order.

(c) The society runs 37 retail stores spread all over Delhi/New De'hi and tries to ensure that all essential items of daily use (inc'uding rationeal commodities) are avai'ab'e at a'l times in all these stores. However, wehn there is heavy demand for particular items, shortages do occur sometimes but repleneshment of stock is done at the, earlist.
