The Minister of Education (Dr. K. L. Shrimali): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The building is reported to be almost complete.

Students' Hostels for Gulburga Engineering College

872. Shri Madhusudan Rao: Will the Minister of Scientific Research and Cultural Affairs be pleased to refer to the reply given to Unstarred Question No. 1209 on the 9th December, 1959 and state

(a) the further progress made in the construction of students' hostels for Gulburga Engineering College;

(b) whether any further amount over and above the sum of Rs. 1 lakh has been sanctioned; and

(c) if so, what is the total amount?

The Minister of Scientific Research and Cultural Affairs (Shri Humayun Kabir): (a) According to a report received from the College, one of the three wings of the hostel has been constructed upto the door level.

(b) and (c). A further sum of Rs. 50,000 has been sanctioned.

Children of Working Mothers in Andhra Pradesh

873. Shrimati Laxmi Bai: Will the Minister of Education be pleased to state:

(a) the number of children of working mothers enjoying the special amenities given by the Central Government through the Central Social Welfare Board in Andhra Pradesh;

(b) the places where the units are functioning at present; and

(c) the amount earmarked for this year and spent so far for this Scheme in Andhra Pradesh?

The Minister of Education (Dr. K. L. Shrimali): (a) The Central Social Welfare Board has initiated and is assisting a number of programmes for child welfare. It is not possible to indicate the number of children of working mothers from the total number of children receiving benefits under these programmes.

(b) and (c). No State-wise or item-wise allocation of funds is made by the Central Social Welfare Board. Information about the Centres/Institutions for child welfare run or assisted by the Board in Andhra Pradesh is being collected and will be laid on the Table of the Sabha as soon as possible.

Centres for Adult Women in Andhra Pradesh

874. Shrimati Laxmi Bai: Will the Minister of Education be pleased to state:

(a) the total number of condensed course centres for adult women functioning in Andhra Pradesh with grant given by the Government of India and their location; and

(b) the strength of pupils at each centres?

The Minister of Education (Dr. K. L. Shrimali): (a) A statement is laid on the Table of the Sabha. [See Appendix II, annexure No. 40].

(b) The grant of the Central Social Welfare Board is intended for imparting training to batches of about 25 students in each unit whereas the Government Special Schools for Adult Women admit 40 candidates to the 1st year class.
