The Central Statistical Organisation was closely associated with the work of this expert committee. For the purpose of long-term planning, the Central Statistical Organisation also extended the projections upto 1971.

(b) The results are published by the Central Statistical Organisation in the December, 1959, issue of the "Monthly Abstract of Statistics", copies of which are available in the Parliament Library.
