The Prime Minister and Minister of External Affairs (Shri Jawaharlal Nehru): (a) Yes; a small expert committee set up by the Planning Commission's Working Group on Vital and Health Statistics went into the question of providing a uniform set of estimates of population and prepared estimates of all-India population upto 1966 by States, sex and broad agegroups. The Central Statistical Organisation was closely associated with the work of this expert committee. For the purpose of long-term planning, the Central Statistical Organisation also extended the projections upto 1971.

(b) The results are published by the Central Statistical Organisation in the December, 1959, issue of the "Monthly Abstract of Statistics", copies of which are available in the Parliament Library.

Radio Rural Forums in Madras State

15. Shri Subbiah Ambalam: Will the Minister of Information and Broadcasting be pleased to refer to the reply given to Starred Question No. 515 on the 2nd December, 1959 and state:

(a) the number of Radio Rural Forums or Clubs formed in the Community Development Blocks in Madras State after the launching of the scheme of Radio Broadcasts on Agriculture; and

(b) the number of enquiries received from each of these Forums by the A.I.R. Stations in Madras State?

The Minister of Information and Broadcasting (Dr. Keskar): (a) Radio Rural Forums have not so far been formed in Madras State but the State Government are finalising arrangements for the start of the Farm Forums which are expected to start shortly.

The Minister of Industry (Shri Manubhai Shah): (a) There are 36 Khadi centres in Tripura and 3 in Manipur.

(b) the articles produced are Shirtings, Dhoties, Sarees, Pachra, Chaddars, Towels and Coating.
