- (b) if so, the details thereof and what steps Government have taken to check this;
- (c) whether Central Government have advised States in this regard; and
  - (d) if so, the details thereof and if not the reasons therefor?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRIES OF AGRICUL-TURE AND RURAL DEVELOP-(KUMARI KAMLA MENT KUMARI): (a) to (d). The problem of fungus in foodgrains is being looked into by a number of organisations, such as, the National Institute of Nutrition, Hyde abad and the Central Food Technological Research Institute, Mysore High moisture content in foodgrains favours the development of fungus resulting in Maximum limits damage moisture content in foodgrains are fixed under Prevention of Food Adulteration Act and Rules, and also in the specifications laid down for purchase of foodgrains. The foodmoisture grains having within these safe limits are not damaged by fungus. The specifications are circulated to the FCI and the State Governments and agencies, and are followed by them in the purchase of foodgrains for the State and Central stocks.

In the Extension Programmes carried out through 17 Save Grain Campaign Offices, throughout country the importance of drying of foodgrains for avoidance of losses due to moisture and fungus is emphasised.

## Execution of Kahnupur Irrigation Project (Orissa)

This Project is at present under examination in the Central Water Commission in consultation with the State Government and is yet to be approved by the Planning Commission. The project has not been included by the Government of Orissa in their Sixth Plan.
