Vacant Plots in the Colonies of Gujaranwala Town Co-operative House Building Society

2333. SHRI ZAINUL BASHER : Will the Minister of WORKS AND HOUSING be pleased to state :

(a) the number of plots still lying vacant for the last more than two years in the Gujranwala 'Town Part I & II, the colonies of the Gujranwala Town Co-operative House Building Society Limited, Delhi on which construction of houses has not been undertaken so far and the action taken by D.D.A. against the defaulters; and

(b) whether he will have the matter investigated and freeze all these plots and put them to public auction and put an end to all this racketeering by unscrupulous elements?

THE MINISTER OF PARLIA-MENTARY AFFAIRS AND WORKS AND HOUSING (SHRI BHISHMA NARAIN SINGH) (a) The Delhi Development Authority have reported that according to the survey of the colony of Gujaranwala Cooperative House Building Society conducted recently, there are 61 plots lying vacant in parts I & II of this colony. These include 15 plots which are lying unallotted because the matter is sub-judice.

The Delhi Development Authority have also reported that action is being initiated against the sublessees who have violated the provision of sub-lease deed by not completing the construction within the stipulated period.

(b) In view of irregularities in the society, the Registrar Cooperative Societies superseded the management of the society and has appointed an administrator. The Registrar, Cooperative Society has reported that no specific complaints of racketeering have been received by him.
